A Survey

Listed below are about a quarter of the "belief statements" people brought to class last Thursday. Some, it seems to me, are statements someone could decide whether she believes or not, and others aren't – that is, they're not a statement you could preface with either "I believe that . . . " or "I deny that" Your assignment is to think about which category each of these falls into. If you think it's that kind of statement, check the "Yes" box; if it's not, check "No." If you think that there's a clear condition under which someone could make the decision, check the "Depends" box (if you can indicate in a phrase what it depends on, you can write that in the space under it).

Please bear in mind: this isn't asking whether *you* believe the statement, but about whether you think you, or anyone, could answer yes or no to the question, "do you believe this?"

It's probably a good idea to do this in two or three different sessions – maybe one page at a time, and then go do something else for a while and come back..

When you've finished, write a short explanation at the end of which one or two gave you the

most trouble, and why.
